All submissions due by March 2, 2012.

Submission Types

1. **Poem** – Please make sure that you format your poem (if typing) exactly as you want it to appear. Poems should be no more than one typed page long.
2. **Short story or essay** – Stories and essays should be double-spaced, and should not exceed 500 words (or one standard, double-spaced typed page).
3. **Artwork** – Submit artwork in camera-ready format (dark, clear strokes show up best) on a sheet no larger than 8.5x11. Note that all artwork will be published in black and white. Color pictures do not reproduce well. Also, please send in artwork on unlined paper only please.

Each student may submit up to three entries for consideration. The editors of *The Lion's Roar* reserve the right to edit work as needed, and final approval for all entries will be at the discretion of the principal.

Submission Formats

Word documents emailed directly to the magazine are preferred. Please use 12-pt. Times New Roman font with 1-inch margins all the way around. However, please also submit a hard copy with a signed cover sheet to the magazine through school mail. If it is not possible to email a copy of your submission, a hand-written submission alone is acceptable.
